Complete medicated products for bacterial diseases treatment

Medicated products are special diets to be used against bacterial diseases of fish. They contain antibiotic premixes registered by the Italian Health Ministry and approved by the European legislation. Therapeutic suggestions are to be confirmed with a sensitivity test to antibiotics. Skretting medicated products are supplied only on veterinary prescription.
